## **Green IT in Wireless Access Networks**

The workshop will take place at T-Labs in Berlin on November 29th, 2012, in their office in Winterfeldtstraße 21, D-10781 Berlin. We solicit:

- Project presentations
- Visionary (possibly provocative) presentations

The importance of GreenIT is growing. Energy efficiency becomes an important business factor in communication and for the network service providers. Studies have shown that there is huge potential for energy savings in the access networks by for example shifting end-systems to other available access technologies or cells of the same technology.

The objective of this workshop is to bring stakeholders of this topic from telecom operators, manufacturers, and academia together to discuss the resulting challenges related to system optimization in wireless networks. Topics of particular interest include, but are not limited to:

- Use cases and challenges, new business models
- Architectures and protocols for energy efficient mobile networks
- Modeling and measurement of energy consumption
- Mechanisms for network offloading, base station cooperation, D2D communication
- Mechanisms for radio resource management & signal processing
- Cross-Layer Design principles
- Context awareness (location, time, events, etc.)
- Prediction mechanisms (knowledge, artificial intelligence, etc.)

The workshop program will be published end of October 2012. Participants should register via email by November 15, 2012.
