In order to fulfill these expectations the business of Mobile TV (still) has to get past some major hurdles and changes: The convergence of broadcasting with mobile communication leading to new market and business models competing with the well-established models of classic broadcasting, a increasing variety of standard and technology choices (DVB-H, DMB, MediaFLO, MBMS), frequency regulation aspects, availability of suitable content and solutions for digital rights management - to mention just a few of them.

Topics of particular interest for this workshop should be related but are not limited to mobility aspects and include:

- Mobile TV enabling technologies
- Operator strategies
- Business / regulatory models
- New applications and services
- Ongoing standardization activities
