Vehicular Communication

The workshop will take place at Ericsson Research in Aachen/Herzogenrath on March 15th, 2018, in Ericsson Allee 1, D-52134 Herzogenrath. We solicit:

- Technical overview presentations
- Presentations on open questions and challenges
- Project presentations
- Presentations of results of ongoing research
- Visionary (possibly provocative) presentations

Vehicles on public roads and automated guided vehicles (AGVs) in industrial complexes can highly benefit from wireless communication. Many vehicular applications exist and are being developed, often forming complex relations among stake holders and respective value- and responsibility chains. This extends e.g. from on-board entertainment over predictive maintenance up to safety critical services like cooperate decision making for maneuvers.

The objective of this workshop is to bring stakeholders of this topic like automotive/AGV OEMs and suppliers, telco vendors and operators, policy makers, certification bodies and academia together to discuss the state of the art and trends in vehicular communication. Topics of particular interest include, but are not limited to:

- Current trends and future challenges including novel use-cases
- Vehicular communication specific standards, protocols, and policies
- Service / application specific and generic architectures
- Modelling techniques, including cross-domain ones
- Performance evaluation by analysis, simulation, or lab testbeds
- Pre-deployment studies, including best practice for their setup and operation
- Liability and other legal aspects, including certification
